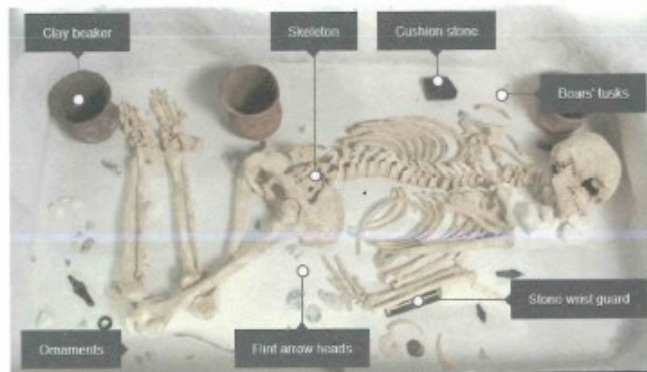

Dear diary,

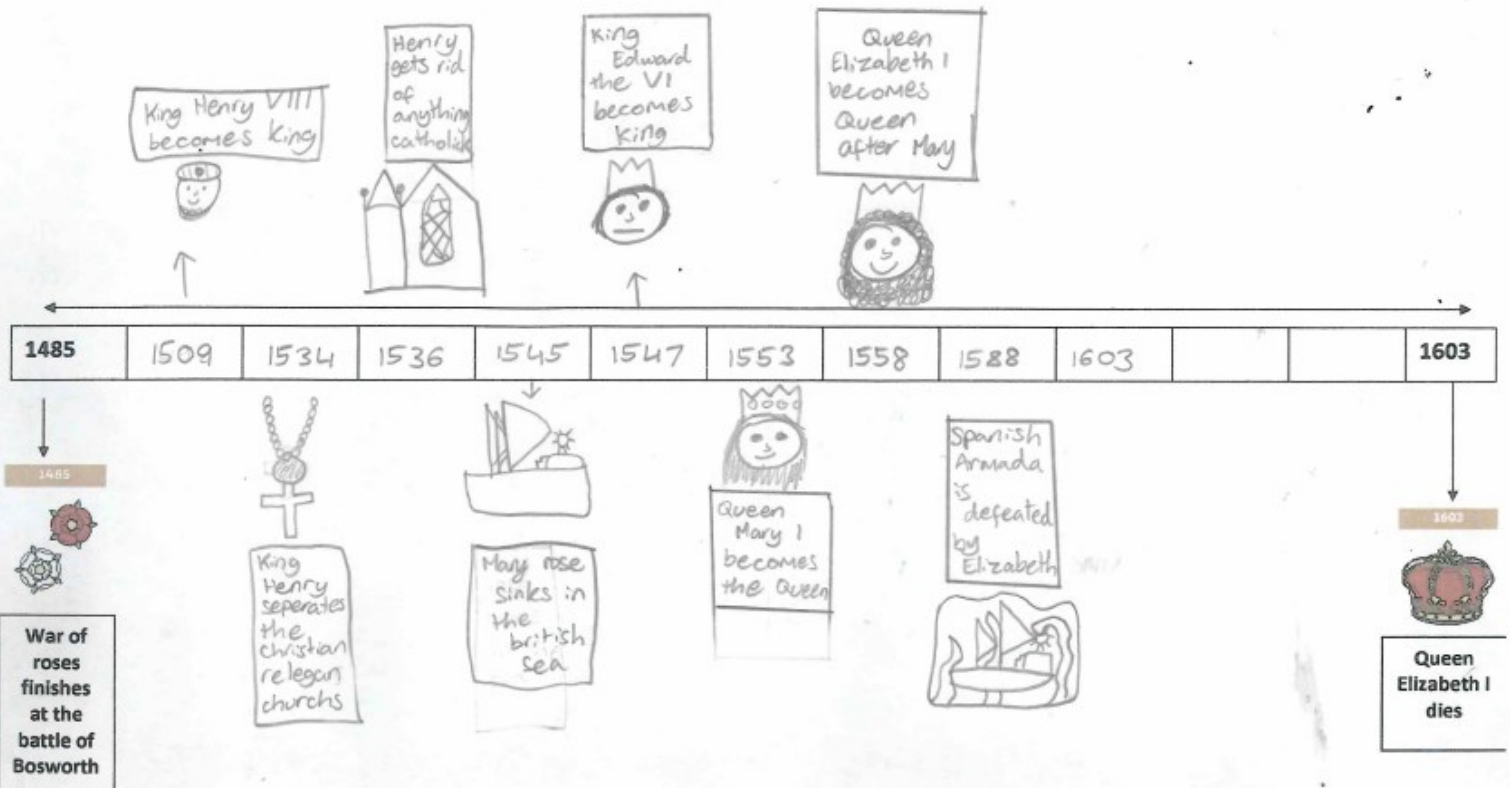

What can you see in the photo?

I can see a large family with two dogs in an anderson shelter. There are many provisions and valuables including a gas mask, tinned food and a flask.

How are the family feeling? How do you know?
