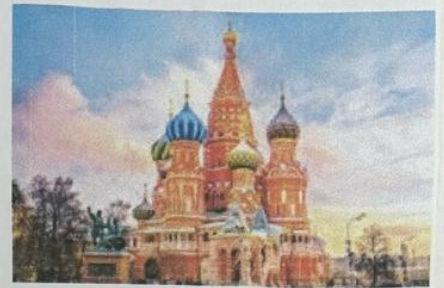

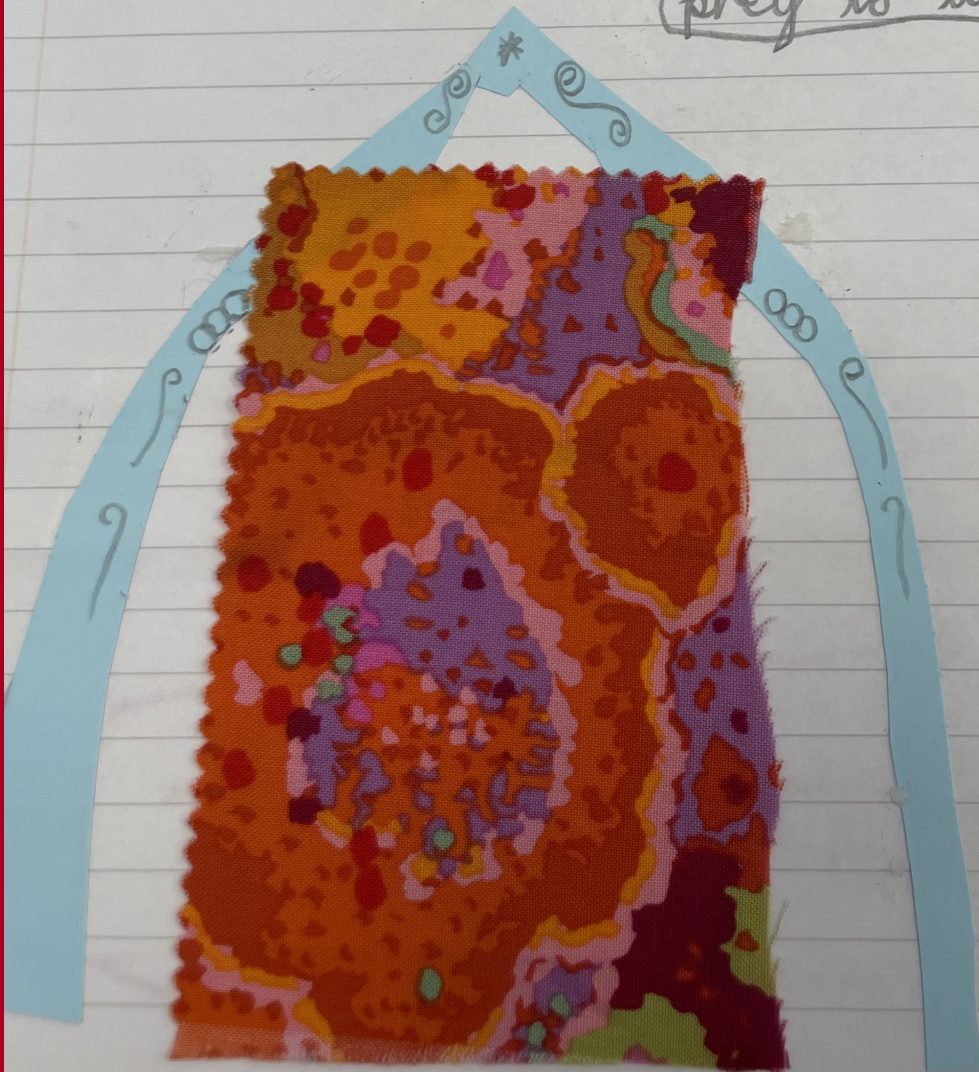

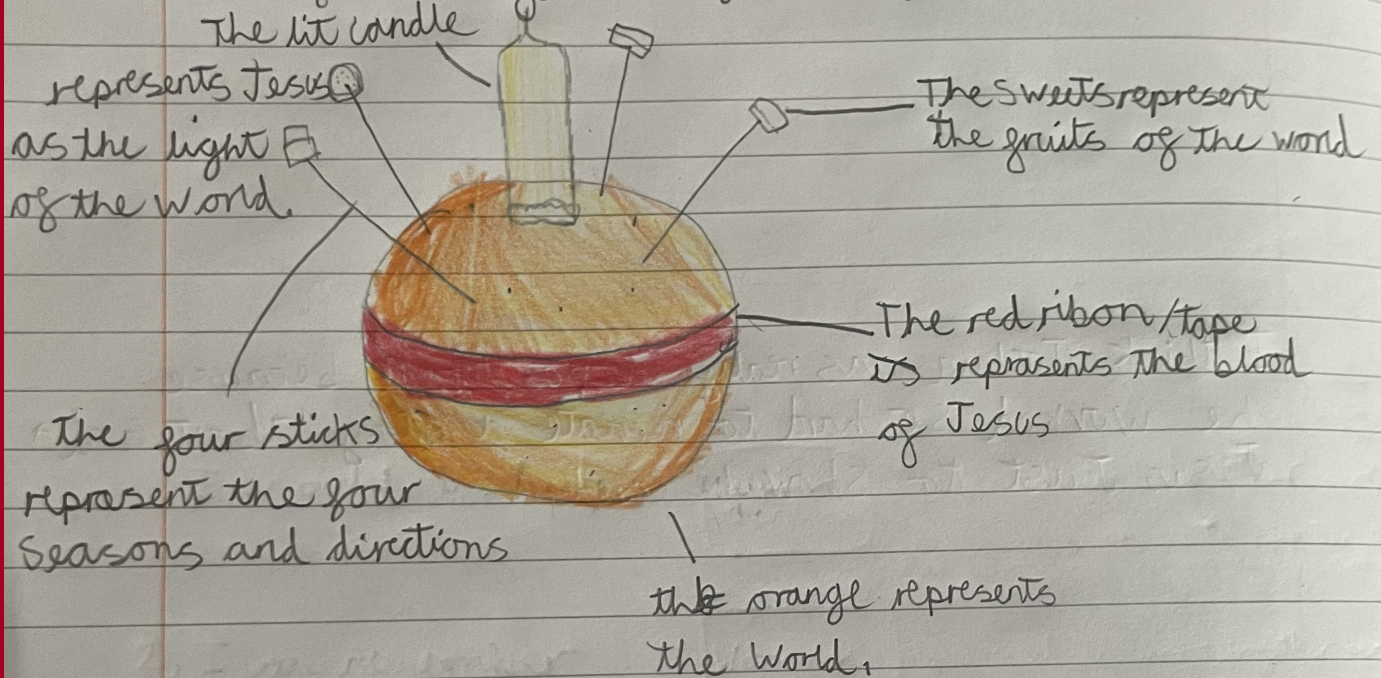

craving. This state

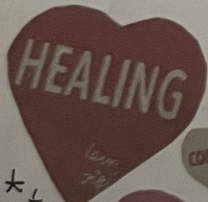
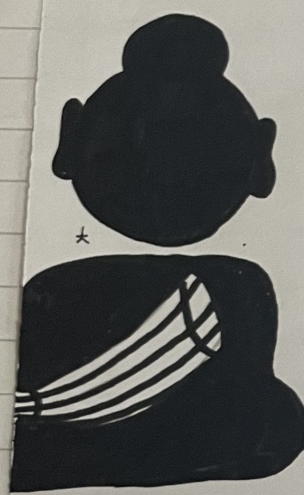
is known as Nirvana.
