Breakfast Club

Opens at 7.30am until the start of the school day at 8.40am. Term time only. Closed on INSET days.

Breakfast will be served until 8.25am. Children will be able to choose from a selection of cereals, porridge, toast, fruit, and yoghurt. Water and occasional hot chocolate will also be served.

After School Care Club

Opens at 3.10pm until 6pm. Term time only. Closed on INSET days and the last day of each term.

Snacks are provided at the start of the session; toast, breadsticks and fruit. Water are also available during these sessions. A meal is served at 5pm. Parents are welcome to send children in with their own snacks or packed tea. We adhere to a NO NUT POLICY

Staff

All staff have a Disclosure and Barring certificate and have completed safeguarding training. The manager and deputy hold paediatric first aid certification and staff are continually updating their training.

Children's Information

Please keep emergency details and information about children's medical and dietary needs up to date.

Facilities

Our Care Club provision is located in a purpose built stand alone building with it's own access from Beavers Road, as well as use of the school hall. Children will eat together at dining tables in the hall. They have access to lots of toys and games for indoor play: including; crafts, board games, construction, painting, books etc. Throughout the year, the children will have supervised access to the school playground for outdoor activities. We provide a variety of toys, games etc. Children are welcome to do homework. Children should not bring in their own toys and games, valuables or money.

Prices

Accounts need to be in credit to make bookings and cancellations must be made 48 hours in advance or the session will be charged for.

Breakfast -(7.30am—8.40am) - £7.50 per session.

Half session (3.10-4.30pm) - £7.50 per session

Half session (4.30-6pm) - £9 per session

Full session (3.10-6pm) - £15 per session

A £5 registration fee will be charged. Care Club bookings will be made and paid for via ScoPay
