

## School Uniform

School uniform items with the school logo are purchased from Brenda's School Uniform shop, 130 Frimley Road, Camberley, GU15 2QN or at [www.brendas.co.uk](http://www.brendas.co.uk) (*Items indicated in italics.*) If you wish to use a school computer or need assistance with purchasing online ask in the school office.

Basic grey or white items can be purchased from any supplier.

<b>Autumn and Spring</b>
<i>All children in KS1 will need a book bag.</i>
<i>Red sweatshirt with school logo or</i>
<i>Red cardigan with school logo.</i>
<b>Reception and Years 1 &amp; 2</b> can wear a white or red polo shirt <b>without</b> a tie
<b>Children in KS2</b> must wear a school shirt with a proper tie (no elasticated ties) - striped silver/red. No polo shirts for KS2 in autumn/spring term.
Grey trousers (not skinny leg) or grey skirt or pinafore dress or culottes
School shoes in black or red – <b>no trainers or ballet style pumps.</b>
Hair accessories should be in red or grey and small. Hair longer than shoulder length needs to be tied back.
<b>Summer</b>
Red and white cotton checked dresses. Knee length grey shorts with white or red polo shirt (no tie).
School shoes in black or red. No open-toed sandals. <b>No bare feet. Children must wear socks always.</b>
Children need a hat in sunny weather.
<b>PE kit</b>
<i>Red T-shirt with school logo.</i>
<i>Black shorts (not cycling shorts).</i>
Inexpensive trainers (no plimsolls).
<i>Red hoodie with school logo (school jumper or cardigan can be worn)</i>
<i>Black jogging bottoms</i>

### **Jewellery**

For health and safety reasons the children must not wear any jewellery to school. If children have pierced ears they may only wear small studs, no hoops please. Earrings must be removed for PE. If your child is not yet able to take out and put back their earrings they must not wear earrings to school on the days that they have PE. If you plan to have your child's ears pierced we suggest that it is done at the start of the long summer holiday to allow for the first six weeks when the earrings may not be removed.
