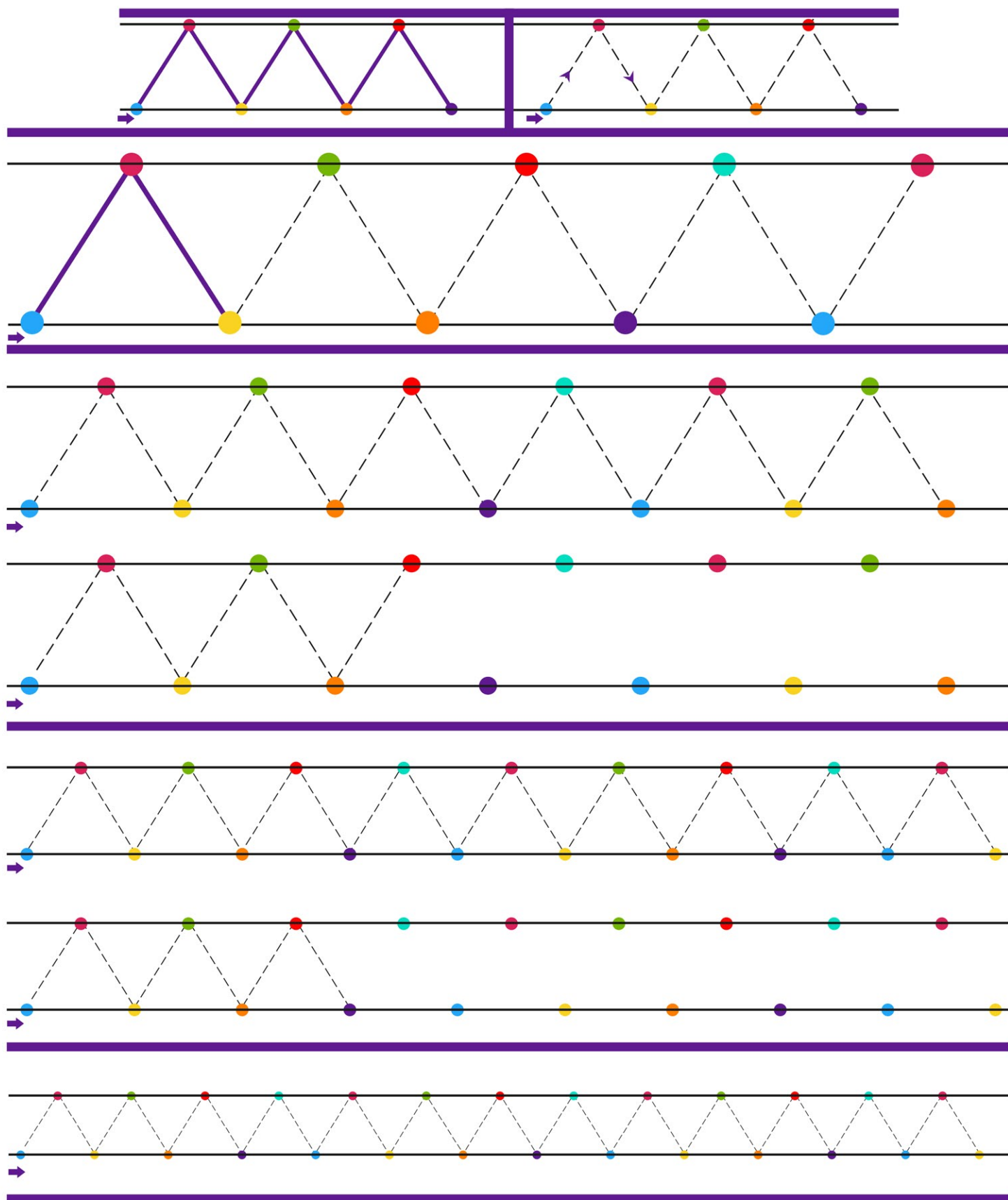

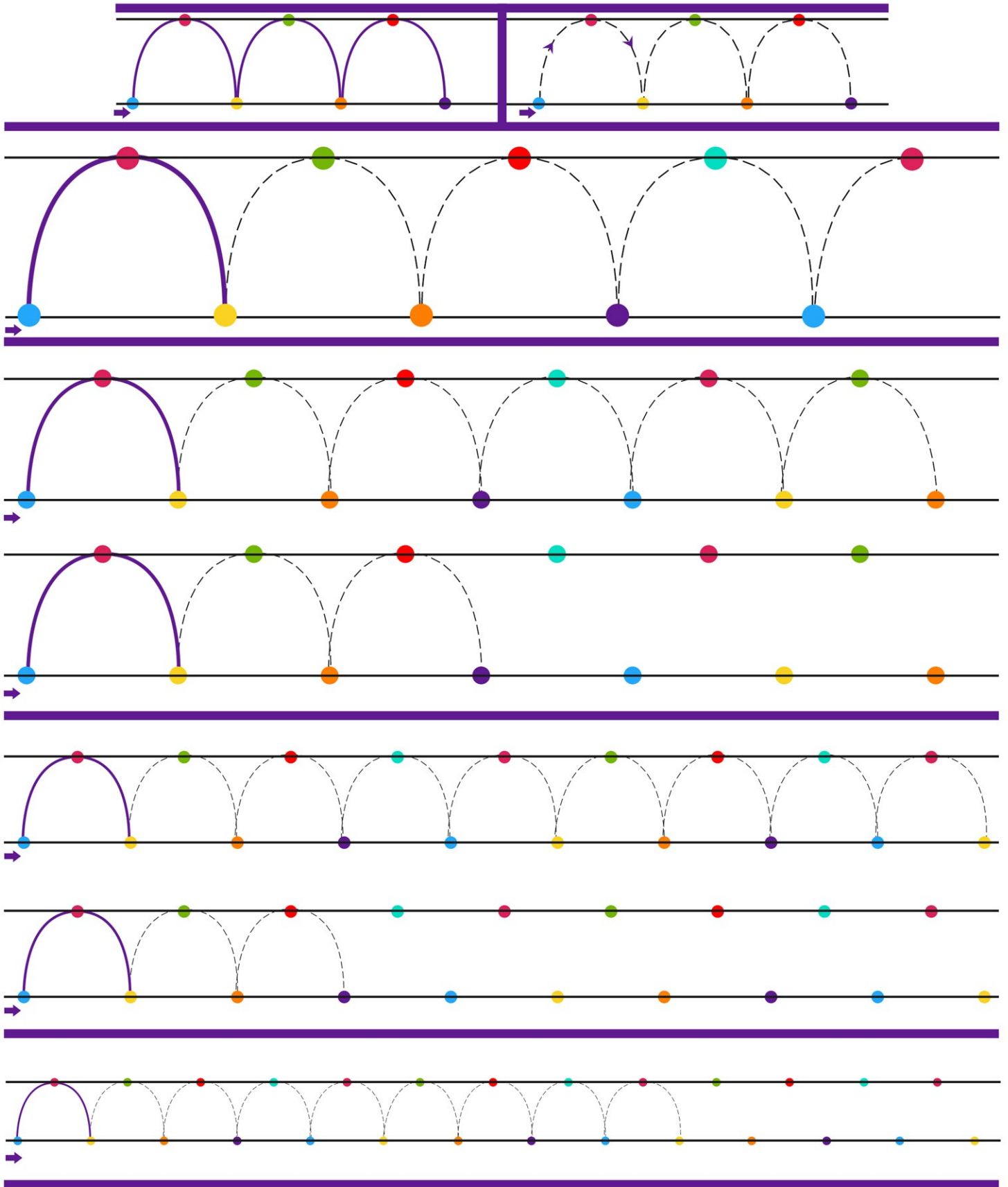
Can you follow the lines to make the patterns?
